

# THE GREEN GIANT TRAIL

Can you find the green giants hiding around Tarman's Copse? Find explorer discs along the way....then, if you dare, go hunting for trolls in Wykery Copse!


Have you discovered the green giants lurking around the woods in Jennett's Park, Bracknell? Aimed at younger children (aged 3-7), this short, fun trail leads you first around Tarman's Copse to discover the green giants, finding explorer discs along the way on the information pillars. You can then extend your trail to Wykery Copse and run along the amazing boardwalk all the way through the woods to escape the trolls!



## LOCATION & PARKING

You can find Tarman's Copse on Google Maps: [Tarman's Copse](#). The entrance to Wykery Copse is off Bunce View/Butler Drive here: [Wykery Copse](#). (N.B. Not to be confused with Wykery Copse Open Space—the actual woods are on the opposite side of the Peacock Lane).

There are parking restrictions on many of the residential roads in Jennett's Park. You can use the free parking at the Jennett's Park Community Centre (Tawny Owl Square RG12 8EB) or a bit further away at the Peacock Meadow's car park (Swift Fields RG12 8BX). Take a pushchair for little legs!



## DIRECTIONS

Directions are given within the trail itself. I've also created a Google Maps trail map below, which you can find online here:

Start at point A marked with a red arrow, on the footpath leading from Falcon Way and running parallel with Blackcap Lane (Please check Google Maps for more detail)

## THE GREEN GIANT TRAIL—TARMAN'S COPSE

Start your trail at the entrance to the Copse from the footpath leading from Falcon Way (running parallel with Blackcap Lane).

Marked A on the Map with a red arrow: [Green Giant Trail Map](#)

### TIME FOR A REST ALREADY.....?

Surely not! The fun trail is only just beginning, but can you spot the woodland bench at the start of your journey?



Can you find the green giant's friends pictured below? How many other animals can you see?



**ARE YOU READY TO SPOT YOUR FIRST GREEN GIANT?** It's time to head into the woods! Take the path to the left of the bench....



Continue straight on up the path....but be careful...it won't be long until you spy the little green giant lurking in the trees. Shout out when you see him! He's very friendly though. Move closer and see if you can stare into his eyes!




## FEE-FI-FO-FUM!!

As you continue along the path, look carefully at all the trees....can you hear something? Fee-fi-fo-fum....



Can you find the beanstalk?  
Do you know the story of Jack and the Beanstalk?  
Who lives at the top in a big castle?



## HEDGEHOG DISC

Time to find your first explorer disc! Walk to the end of the path to find an information post at the entrance. Can you spot the little hedgehog?

Did you know that, as their name suggests, hedgehogs are often found near hedgerows at the edge of woodlands?


## LIMESTONE DISC

Turn back around and go back down the same path you came up, past the beanstalk again, until you come to a path on your left.

Can you find your next explorer disc?

A 17th century kiln was excavated near here, possibly for lime making used in the construction of the first Easthampstead Park House.





## TREES AND LEAVES?

Did you know you can identify a tree by the shape, size and colour of its leaves? Which 2 trees do you think are found in these woods?

Can you remember their names as you may need them later on?!

## COME ON SLEEPY HEAD!

Are you ready to find some more green giants? No time for a sleep yet!

Take the path on the left, venturing further into the woods to discover another path trodden by the green giants.

Can you spot the sleepy head? Can you wake her up?



## THE TREE GIANT

Continue further down the path...what's that hiding in the trees?

Wow! Can you see the giant that has been carved into a tree?!

Do you recognise the leaves tumbling down over his head?





## SOMEBODY'S WATCHING YOU....

Carry on down the track.....but be careful....I think you're being watched....

Keep an eye out!

## WHERE ARE THEY HIDING?

You never know where the little forest friends might be hiding.

Search high and low for down a tunnel they might go....



## BLUEBELL DISC

Did you know these woods are full of beautiful bluebells in the Spring?

Where the path meets another, find your next explorer disc....

## GREEN GIANT COIN?

With your back to the bluebell disc, turn right up the path towards an exit out of the woods.

But don't leave the woods yet...look around to find a giant golden coin hiding in the trees.

Look out for another information post for the next clue....



## COTTAGE DISC

What would you buy with a giant golden coin? Maybe a nice little cottage in the woods?

No time to daydream though...you have to find your final explorer disc! You are nearly at the end of the trail!



## SWEET CHESNUT DISC

Turn back round and run all the way back past the bluebell disc, continuing straight on down until you find another post.

Can you remember the tree leaves—look around carefully to find your final disc!


## GREEN GIANT THRONE

Turn right at the fork and you'll soon find a big tree-like throne. Very carefully and only with the help of a grown-up, sit on the throne and celebrate your fantastic explorer skills!



## WYKERY COPSE

Follow the online Map through Tarman's Copse Open Space and Harrier Green. Turn left down the path to then cross Peacock Lane at the crossing over to Butler Drive. Follow Butler Drive as it bends to the right all the way to the entrance to Wykery Copse



## GIANT SEATS

Can you spot the giant seats?  
Which one will you choose to sit on?

Do you recognise the shape of the back of the seat?

## BOARDWALK

Enter the woods and start your journey along the boardwalk, through the trees and over the stream....

But be careful, you might have to run away before the green giant trolls come out to play!



## THE START OR THE END?

Did you manage to escape the trolls? Have you made it all the way to the end of the boardwalk in one piece? Well done! Time for another sit down....but wait, is this the same green giant seat as before...or maybe something is different?
